Technology - talking stories, cameras, using the board to play games, iPads and simple software.

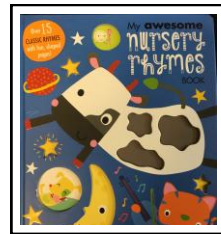
Turn taking and beginning to play with others - sharing toys and taking turns

Being friends and taking part in group activities in and outside the classroom

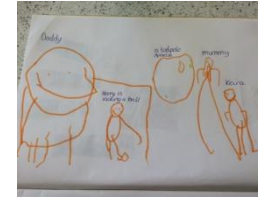


Mathematics
