PRIMARY STATUS I have spoken with the Local Authority this morning and information is beginning to be gathered. I will send information on as I receive it.

HEADLICE We have had a few cases since we have returned to school. Please see the information attached from Louise hart, the school nurse.

MEASLES, CHICKEN POX AND SHINGLES One of our pupils is receiving medical treatment which puts them at risk if they are exposed to measles, chicken pox or shingles.

The best way to protect our pupil from measles is for all children at school to be immunised against measles. Please would you discuss measles immunisation with your GP if your child has not already received it. If your child is suspected of having measles, you should let us know immediately.

Our pupil is also at risk from chicken pox and would need to be given an injection within three days of contact. If your child is suspected of having chicken pox you should let us know immediately.

It is also important that you let us know if there is shingles in your household.

Your child is not at any risk whatsoever from this situation. However, the health and well-being of our pupil who is at risk, does depend on the co-operation of all other parents and we hope you can help us.

We will be stressing the importance of washing hands and would appreciate your full support with this.
